



## Acceptable Identification Required to Vote in City of Corner Brook Municipal Election

Identification is required to register to vote and/or register to vote by mail. Acceptable identification includes either:

- one valid government issued photo ID which displays your signature, and **current civic address** (e.g. driver's license)

**or**

Two piece of non-photo identification one of which displays your current address:

- Bank statement
- Birth certificate
- Blood donor card
- Certificate of Canadian Citizenship
- Credit Card/Debit Card
- Government Issued Payment Stub
- Health Card/MCP
- Identify Bracelet issued by a hospital or long-term care facility
- Income tax assessment
- Letter of confirmation of Residence from a communal or commercial residence manager, operator or owner
- Library card
- Mortgage/Lease or Tenant/Agreement
- Prescription label
- Property tax assessment
- Public Transportation Card
- Social Insurance Number Card
- Student Identify Card
- Utility bill
- Vehicle registration, insurance certificate or policy
